# ACES Learning Center Course Syllabus E104B: Reading and Writing in Context

### **Course Objectives and student competencies:**

- 1. Students will read challenging, above-grade-level passages, both fiction and non-fiction.
- 2. Students will learn new vocabulary words in the context of reading passages.
- 3. In the spring semester, students will benefit from a greater emphasis on writing skills, applying and reinforcing new vocabulary learned in the fall semester.

#### Class Structure:

Class will include analysis of reading passages, discussion of homework reading, practice with new vocabulary words, and longer writing assignments.

# **Required Materials:**

Students will bring pencil, paper, and a folder to all classes. Students will need a copy of novel for the semester. The class will vote on the first day, choosing from a list of challenging novels selected by the instructor.

## **Class Assignments:**

Students will complete assigned reading and answer comprehension questions over the assigned novel and reading passages. Students will also complete longer creative writing assignments.
