Problem 1. Use appropriate algebraic properties of numbers to remove the parentheses in the following expressions and simplify the results whenever possible.

Problem 2. Find the solution to the following one-variable equation. Write down the major steps of your solution process.

$$5(x+6) + 3 = 27 + 4x.$$

Problem 3. Solve the following one-variable inequality. Write down the major steps of your solution process.

$$-3(2x-3) + 4 \ge 2x - 21.$$

Problem 4. Find the slope, the x-intercept and the y-intercept of the line described by the equation:

$$6(x-1) + 3(2y-6) = 4.$$

Problem 5. Solve the following system of two-variable equations. Write down the major steps of your solution process.

$$\begin{cases} 3x + 5y = -2 \\ 5x - 7y = 12 \end{cases}$$
