2019 Summer Enrichment Course Syllabus

Course Name: Elementary Grammar – Level III and IV Analysis for 4th-5th Graders

Course Description

ACES Grammar Level III and IV Analysis is a continuation of Level I and II Analysis. Grammar is the foundation for punctuation, writing, and vocabulary usage. Grammar is taught through four level analyses: (1) parts of speech, (2) parts of sentences, (3) phrases and clauses, (4) sentence types. Students will work move from written and visual analysis of sentences to mental analysis making grammar clear, concise, and easy to grasp. Pre-requisite: 80% or higher on parts of speech or completion of Level I and II Analysis.

Course Objectives and Student Competencies

- Gain understanding and confidence in more complex aspects of grammar
- Be able to correctly incorporate the lessons into practice
- Write and edit sentences for grammar, punctuation, and correct vocabulary

Class Structure

Each class period will focus on one aspect of the four levels of analyses previously discussed in Level I and II. We will review the basics and do a more in-depth discussion of each while practicing each in longer, more complex sentences and paragraphs. We will revise paragraphs and write our own longer paragraphs practicing each aspect and varying sentence types. Each class period will build onto the next, so students will be practicing and incorporating each new lesson along with the previous lesson(s).
