Course Name: Elementary Grammar – Level I and II Analysis for 4th-5th Graders

Course Description

ACES Grammar utilizes the gifted and talented program from Royal Fireworks Press for its foundation. Grammar is taught through four different levels of analyses: parts of speech, parts of sentences, phrases and clauses, and sentence types. Students will study each level of the analyses. Students will move from written and visual analysis of sentences to mental analysis making grammar clear, concise, and easy to grasp.

Course Objectives and Student Competencies

- Gain familiarity and confidence in aspects of grammar
- Write and edit sentences for grammar, punctuation, and correct vocabulary

Class Structure

Each class period will focus on one aspect of the four levels of analyses. We will discuss the basics of each while practicing each level, reading examples, and writing our own sentences using the lessons learned. Each class period will build onto the next, so students will be practicing each new lesson along with the previous lesson(s).
