

# ACES Academic Enrichment Center 2019 Summer Enrichment Course Syllabus

## Course Name: Creative Writing – Hero Journey, Mystery for 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Graders

#### **Course Description**

ACES creative writing - hero journey or mystery explores the hero's journey or mystery as a model for completing a written narrative. Using the six traits<sup>1</sup> of writing, students will recognize elements of excellent writing. In addition, students will study examples of the hero's journey or mystery in order to better understand the trope or genre. Students will engage in daily prompts to stimulate the imagination and undertake various exercises in word choice and sentence fluency to hone writing skills. By the end of the course, students will complete a multi-page, polished, short story narrative.

## **Course Objectives and Student Competencies**

- Gain confidence and skills as creative writers
- · Learn the essential components of fictional narratives
- Become more fluent in use of grammatical constructions and vocabulary through writing and practice

## **Class Structure**

Class begins with a short discussion of an assigned reading. Each day we will go through one of the six "traits" and practice writing each piece.
