Course Name: Advanced Public Speaking for 6th – 8th Graders

Course Description

In order for students to truly master public speaking, they must be able to speak confidently on serious issues, they must be able to entertain the audience and keep their attention, and they must be able to persuade the audience. In Advanced Public Speaking, students will be tasked with giving long and tasking speeches in order to improve their emotional expression, their ability to entertain, and ultimately their ability to persuade audience members.

Course Objectives and Student Competencies

- Master the ability to speak confidently on serious global and national issues
- Learn how to effectively entertain audiences, and to pace their speeches
- Hone their persuasion skills, as well as their ability to express emotions

Class Structure

Speech or improvisation warm-ups will begin each class followed by completing homework speeches, introduction to new speech topic/issue, and extemporaneous or impromptu speech.
