Course Name: SAT/ACT Essay Writing for 6th – 8th Graders

Course Description

SAT/ACT Essay writing will focus on the fundamentals for writing a strong essay on test day. Students will gain practice writing essays, reading various persuasive essays, and learning how to manage time and stress during the essay portion of the test. Students will study the different aspects of a rhetorical analysis, learn how to debate persuasively using the perspectives of others to back up their own claims. Students will practice using real ACT/SAT essay prompts.

Course Objectives and Student Competencies

- Write persuasive essays under time constraints
- · Gain skills planning and outlining essays and creating strong thesis statements

Class Structure

Class begins with a short reading of a type of passage used in the essay section. The writing topic of the day is developed and discussed, and students have a chance to practice with timed writing exercises. Students share their writing and gain practice proofreading.
